



# PHARMACIST CHECKLIST

## For Completing the Administration of Injections Program

The British Columbia Pharmacy Association (BCPhA) Administration of Injections Program includes two components:

### Immunization Competency Program for BC Health Professionals

This online pre-study is composed of 15 modules and will take approximately eight hours to complete. Pharmacists must achieve 70 per cent on the pre-study test prior to being enrolled in the practical workshop.

### Practical Administration of Injections for BC Pharmacists

This full-day workshop includes practical training on administering subcutaneous, intradermal, and intramuscular injections. Pharmacists must successfully administer an intramuscular and a subcutaneous injection to receive certification of completion for the workshop.

## Steps to register for the BCPhA Program:

### ■ Register for a UBC Campus Wide Login

A CWL is required to access the on-line pre-study portion of the program. If you do not already have a CWL, instructions on how to obtain one can be found here: [\[LINK TO CWL REGISTRATION HERE\]](#)

### ■ Submit application form and payment to BCPhA

### ■ Submit Waiver of Liability (Part of registration form)

Once payment has been received by BCPhA, you will be emailed instructions on how to access the online pre-study portion of the program. When you have successfully completed the online pre-study with a passing grade of 70 per cent or more, you will receive confirmation of enrollment in the workshop portion of the Administration of Injections program. Certificates of completion for both components will be provided at the workshop.

## Getting authority to administer injections:

To be granted authority to administer injections by the College of Pharmacists of BC (CPBC), a pharmacist must submit the following to the CPBC:

### ■ Certification in CPR and first aid

### ■ Certification of completion of the online pre-study

“Immunization Competency Program for BC Health Professionals”

This certificate is provided at the Practical Administration of Injections for BC Pharmacists workshop.

### ■ Certification of completion of the “Practical Administration of Injections for BC Pharmacists” workshop

This certificate is provided at the end of the workshop upon successful “live” administration of an intramuscular and subcutaneous injection.
